Adjudication Process

An independent panel of judges made up of business leaders and enterprise support agencies will assess and mark all applicants' business plans.

The judges will be looking for the following aspects in the competition entries:

- Entrant shows ability to spot a gap in the market for a new product or service
- Leadership and vision of an entrepreneur
- Presentation and marketing of the new or improved product or service
- The reality of the business plan for the first three years
- Providing financial and cash flow forecasts
- The unique/innovative/ degree of originality of the product or service
- Possible sources of funds to launch new business or undertake expansion
